1. Fourth Degree History and Purpose

Formed February 22, 1900

Purpose is to demonstrate patriotism

Represents the *VISIBLE* arm of the Knights of Columbus via the Color Corps.

Appears at parades, attends Funerals, escorts the Bishop, appears at special events.

2. El Camino Real Assembly 85

One of four assemblies in Orange County instituted on August 16, 1964.

Meets the second Thursday at the Brothers of St. Patrick, 7820 Bolsa Ave., Midway City, CA. 6:30 pm dinner an 7:30 pm meeting.

Membership of 400 Sir Knights from 30 councils.

Our Assembly has participated in and won Color Corps competitions at several Exemplification events.

3. Membership Requirements

Must be a Knight for six months and a Third Degree member in good standing at the time of Exemplification.

4. DRESS: The official dress for candidates for the Fourth Degree

Exemplification shall be black bow tie, white *straight* collar shirt, black shoes, black cummerbund and black tuxedo. A member serving in The armed forces of his country shall be considered in proper attire when dressed in military uniform.

The regalia of the Fourth Degree shall consist of the official dress and social baldric.

5. Information about he Fourth Degree.

New members do not have to purchase Regalia or participate in the Color Corps. It is strictly voluntary. However, it is an honor.

Aside from monthly dinner meetings, occasional social and the yearly Memorial Mass, no fund raising or other organized activities are involved as is the case in one's Council.

Membership in the Fourth Degree DOES NOT detract from each member's Council involvement.

6. Reasons for joining the Fourth Degree

To show both a personal and group commitment to patriotism and to support our American way of life.

Presents an opportunity to establish and strengthen liaisons with Brother Knights from other councils.

Affords each Sir Knight the opportunity to participate in the Color Corps.

Provides camaraderie with good Catholic gentlemen.

Provides visible support of our church and country through participation in the Color Corps.

Items to Remember for Fourth Degree Exemplification 2010 El Camino Real—Assembly 85

- The official dress for the Fourth Degree Exemplification is black tuxedo, black bow tie, plain white tuxedo shirt (**NO wing tip shirts**), black shoes, and black cummerbund. Religious and members of the armed services may wear their clerical garb or dress uniform respectively. **NO** lapel pins and jewel of office to be worn during exemplification. **You must have your Third Degree membership card with you for the Fourth Degree Exemplification.**
- Must be a Third Degree member in good standing with 6 months membership in the order.
- Submit Form 4 and \$100 to El Camino Real Assembly by **October 2nd**. This fee includes your dinner, badge, social baldric and 3 months dues. Priests and Brothers fee is \$35.00 and is usually paid by their council. Be sure your **Form 4 is filled out properly** with your **membership number, date of First Degree and signature of your Financial Secretary**. Mail Assembly form and Form 4 to: Jim Berlier 1117 Shelly St., Santa Ana, CA 92704. We **MUST** have your forms and payment **ON TIME** as we are required to vote on your membership and send an **Assembly** check to the Master of the Southern California District.
